

OFF-BASE DRINKING WATER SAMPLING NEAR MARINE CORPS AIR STATION BEAUFORT

The Navy and Marine Corps are conducting drinking water well sampling near MCAS Beaufort beginning in December 2022. The sampling is for certain per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), which may be present in these drinking water wells due to past use of firefighting foam or other PFAS-containing materials on base.

Your property is <u>not</u> located within the sampling area, so the Navy and Marine Corps are not asking to sample your drinking water at this time. Some properties close to yours may be located within the sampling area, and the Navy and Marine Corps are inviting you to attend an Open House:
