The Navy is conducting a private drinking water well investigation in a designated sampling area near Naval Support Activity (NSA) Cutler Fire Station beginning in September 2020.

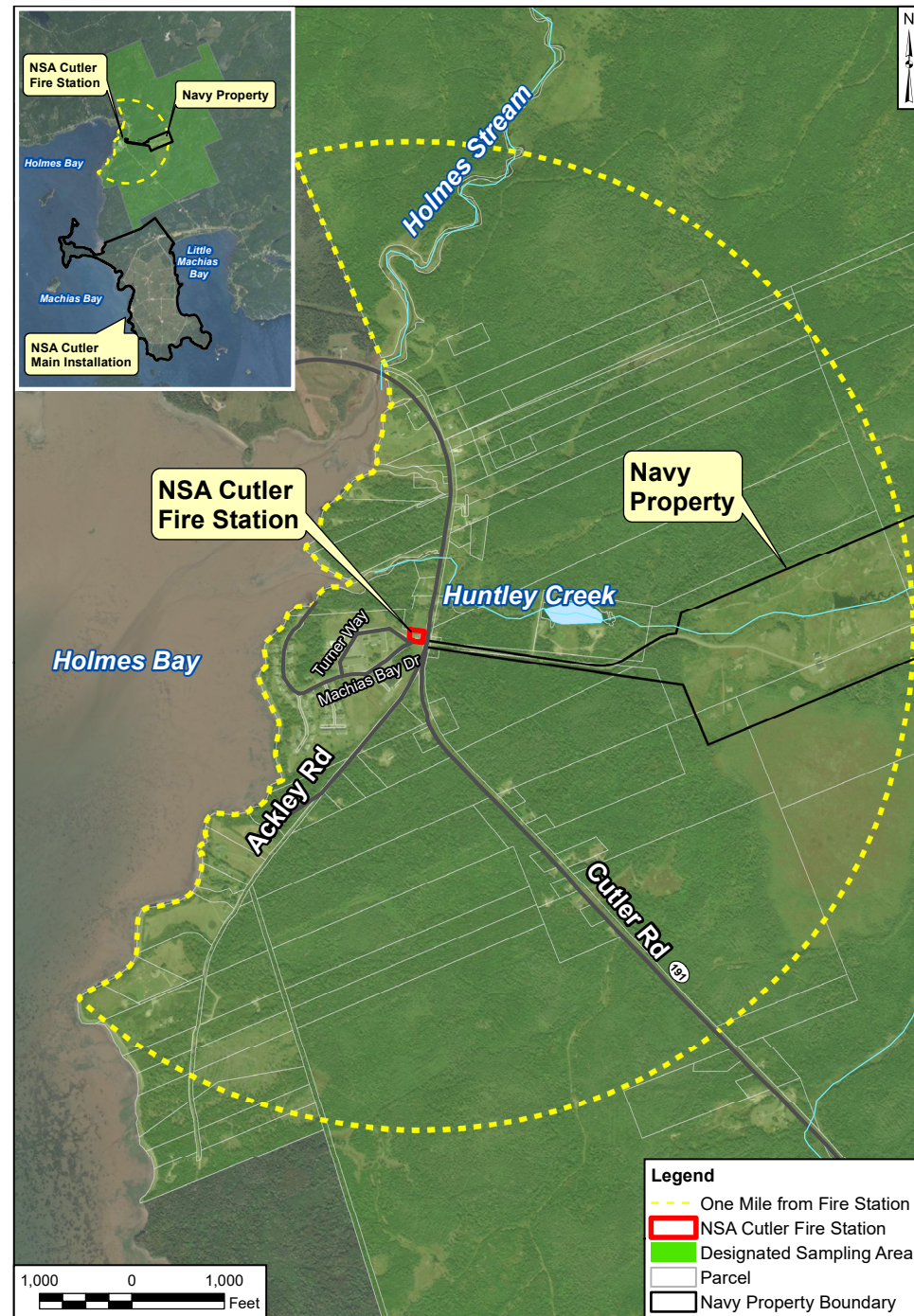
The Navy is testing for certain per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), which may be present in these private drinking water wells due to past uses of certain types of firefighting foam, specifically aqueous film forming foam (AFFF). We are committed to keeping the public informed of the Navy's investigation.
