The Navy is conducting an ongoing private drinking water well investigation in a designated sampling area near Naval Air Station (NAS) Oceana. The Navy is testing for certain per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), which may be present in these private drinking water wells due to past uses of on-base fire-fighting foam, specifically aqueous film forming foam (AFFF).

Although your property is located in the designated sampling area, we will not need to sample your drinking water; we believe your property uses municipal drinking water provided by the City of Virginia Beach and no private drinking water wells are present on your property. If our records are incorrect, and you have a private drinking water well on your property, the Navy would like permission to sample your private drinking water at no cost to you.
