The Naval Facilities Engineering Command (NAVFAC) Engineering and Expeditionary Warfare Center (EXWC) is a command of more than 1,300 dedicated men and women whose mission supports combatant capabilities by providing specialized facilities engineering, technology solutions, and life-cycle management of expeditionary equipment to the Navy, Marine Corps, federal agencies, and other Department of Defense supported commands.

Summary

The Environmental Security Technology Services (ESTS) contract is a performance-based \$99.5M, 5-year Indefinite Quantity/Indefinite Delivery (ID/IQ) contract with worldwide coverage. The contract supports the environmental stewardship mission of the Department of Navy (DON) including Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) in several key scope areas summarized below. The contract is managed by NAVFAC EXWC and awarded to Battelle Memorial Institute (Battelle). This contract supports NAVFAC with environmental services in the areas of: program development and implementation; research, development, testing, and evaluation (RDT&E) of innovative environmental technologies; implementation of innovative environmental technologies, optimized strategies and techniques; and technical consultation.

Scope

Task orders are flexible, performance-based, cost plus fixed fee (CPFF) type awards in the following scope areas:

- Technology Implementation (use of innovative technologies and incorporation of green and sustainable practices)
- Technical Consultation
- RDT&E
- Installation Restoration and Munitions Response
- Range Cleanup, Sustainability, and Management
- Site Operation and Maintenance (O&M)
- Climate Change Initiative (adaptation and mitigation)

- Sustainability (advancing sustainability, reliability, resilience and mission capability of facility, utility, and infrastructure systems)
- Natural Resources
- Training (environmental and health and safety)
- Environmental Compliance

Rapid Response: The contract also features a rapid response capability to provide engineering services and technical support on a short turnaround basis. This includes document review and preparation, conducting site visits, performing optimization evaluations, supporting technical meetings, and preparing presentations. The task order contract can typically be setup within one business day based on the needs of the project.

Users

Worldwide coverage primarily for Navy and Marine Corps customers, but others may apply if it is a joint project or of benefit to DON.

Team Members

The Battelle Team has the skills and resources to address the DON's most challenging environmental issues including nationally recognized technical experts in areas such as complex chlorinated solvent sites, vapor intrusion, emerging contaminants, contaminated sediments, munitions response sites, radiological issues, and sustainability.

ESTS Task Order Process

Customer contacts the EXWC COR for approval to use the contract

Customer forwards the following information to EXWC COR

- Identification of ENV office and funding type
- Performance Work Statement (PWS)
- Independent Government Estimate (IGE)
- Annual execution plan with all data required in association with eProjects including:
 - Project Title
 - Award Execution Date
 - Project Manager
 - Environmental Tracking Office
 - Fund Type
- Promise to pay

Note: Customer must not enter anything into eProjects under the ESTS contract. Inputs must be made by EXWC. All other inputs will be rejected.
