1. In response to reference (a), LANTNAVFACENGCOM recommends:

a. Include all Puerto Rican activities under the NAVSTA ROOSEVELT ROADS IAS, to include NAF Vieques, Camp Garcia, NAVSECGRUACT SABANA SECA; RESUPSHIP San Juan; former NAVSTA San Juan; NAVCOMSTA Isabella Transmitter Site, Aguadilla Low Frequency Transmitter Site, Salinas Receiver Site; West Annex Aguadilla; Ft. Allen; Naval Fuel Oil Storage Facility, Catano; and Culebra Mircorwave Site and Former Observation Post (records search and report only, no on-site visit).

b. Because of the geographic proximity of activities, NAVWPNSTA YORKTOWN/NSC CHEATHAM ANNEX IAS should also include NSC NORFOLK (Yorktown Fuels Division) and DOD AFXTRACTY CAMP PEARY. Further, the NAVRADTRANSFAC SUFFOLK (now being excessed) and HPDTA HARVEY POINT (similar to DOD AFXTRACTY CAMP PEARY) should be added to their FY-83 list.

c. NAVPHIBASE LITTLE CREEK can be delayed to FY-84 and combined in one contract with NAS OCEANA and FLECOMBATRACENLANT VIRGINIA BEACH.

d. Based on enclosures (1) through (3), NAVORDSTA LOUISVILLE should be dropped as a NACIP Candidate Activity.
