

ECC is providing this Summary Letter Report to document the well gauging activities conducted during March 2008 at Site 17, Naval Air Station, Brunswick, Maine (NASB). In a NASB conference call on February 5, 2008 Environmental Protection Agency and Maine Department of Environmental Protection representatives agreed to the suspension of the Long Term Monitoring Plan (LTMP), because of the pending Site 17 Remedial Investigation. The LTMP suspension letter is included as an attachment.

In order to maintain continuity in historical water level data, on March 26, 2008, water level measurements were obtained from six groundwater monitoring wells, (MW-NASB-065, MW-NASB-066, MW-NASB-067, MW-NASB-068, MW-NASB-097, and MW-NASB-098) located at Site 17 and from two groundwater monitoring wells (MW-NASB-0209R and MW-NASB-210) located at the Old Navy Fuel Farm. The Site 17, March 26, 2006, Field Record of Well Gauging is provided as an attachment.



Dear Mr. Daly and Ms. Sait:

As discussed during the Naval Air Station Brunswick (NASB), Maine conference call among the project stakeholders (US EPA, MEDEP and Navy) on 5 February 2008, and presented in Site 17 Monitoring Event Nos. 25 (April 2007) and 26 (September 2007) Reports to discontinue sampling, the Navy is seeking to suspend the Long-Term Monitoring Program (LTMP) sampling during 2008 at Site 17, Building 95. The US EPA and MEDEP representatives agreed to the suspension of the LTM Program at Site 17 during 2008; however, they requested the Navy's request be put in writing regarding the LTMP suspension. In addition, the regulators stated that the suspension of the Site 17 LTM Program will be reviewed in December 2008 to determine if the LTM Program should resume in 2009.
