Dave: Thank you for coordinating with the RIARNG and NGB regarding conducting a Site Inspection under the MMRP at Camp Fogarty and in discussions with EPA and RIDEM on listing the site on under the Navy's Federal Facility Agreement with US EPA Region I and RIDEM. My understanding of significant points and path forward based on our various phone calls and your letter to EPA is as follows:

RIARNG will (and has) notified Navy, EPA, RIDEM in writing of their intent to construct a building at Camp Fogarty at TA-3D in accordance with the requirements specified in the 1993 Transfer Agreement. RIARNG will proceed with a Site Inspection of the TA-3D munitions response site (MRS) to assess whether there is a release of Munitions and Explosives of Concern (MEC) or munitions constituents (MC). Army will fund the Site Inspection, as currently programmed. The RIARNG will coordinate directly with RIDEM and USEPA to ensure that the investigation is conducted in accordance with their guidance. The RIARNG will copy the Navy BRAV PMO on all key documents and all significant and/or formal correspondence with the regulatory agencies. The TA-3D MRS will not be listed as a site under the Navy's FFA at this time; Navy has sent a letter to EPA document this decision. If a release of MEC or MC is identified at the TA-3D MRS, the Navy will add the TA-3D site to the FFA. The National Guard Bureau is not seeking to be an additional signatory on the Navy's FFA, but understands that the ARNG needs to conduct site investigations and response actions in accordance with the provisions stated in that agreement. If the TA-3D MRS is listed in the FFA, the Navy and ARNG will develop a Memorandum of Agreement to establish procedures to collaboratively achieve site closure under the Navy's FFA.

Please let me know of any errors or omissions in this summary.

Thanks again for teaming with us on this project. We really appreciate your responsiveness and good faith effort to keep us on track with the RIARNG MILCON.
