For your information:

The TetraTech field crew out at Calf Pasture Point has reported that all but one of the no swimming/wading signs along the entrance channel shoreline of Calf Pasture Point have become a casualty of this winter's harsh weather. You may recall these signs are not required by remedy but were installed in 2004 by the Navy after detecting a sudden increase in CVOCs in piezometer water samples collected during the December 2003 monitoring event. Please note these signs are not necessary from a remedy protectiveness standpoint as confirmed by the Shoreline Risk Assessment and 5 Year Review.
