The screening analytical data for Narragansett Bay points has come back all ND, even though the southern group was mostly fresh water discharge. I still don't have the validated CLP data for the entrance channel points. There was an estimated hit of DCE (below detection limit) on the eastern end of the entrance channel, but without validation, I don't know if it was real yet.
