Subject: Review Item Area 99 ? Potential Use of Radium-Bearing Paint in Hangar 1 Phase II Environmental Baseline Survey

EPA reviewed the Decision Document for Review Item Area 99 - Potential Use of Radium-Bearing Paint in Hangar 1, Phase II Environmental Baseline Survey, Naval Air Station South Weymouth, Weymouth, Massachusetts, dated September 2009. It recommends no further action (NFA) for RIA 99. This recommendation is based on an historical records review and the results of the December 2004 Radiation Survey, which indicate that no radium-based paint was used and no radioactivity above background levels in the south lean-to is present. The 2004 Radiation Survey, which EPA accepted, has been accurately summarized in this Decision Document. The NFA recommendation is acceptable.
