
Subject: Action Memorandum for OU5, Site 49 - Former Skeet Range (March 2002)  
Naval Air Station Cecil Field, Jacksonville, Florida

Dear Mr. Davidson:

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has reviewed the subject document and finds it adequate for its intended purpose. EPA concurs with the selected action to remove approximately 5,681 cubic yards of soils contaminated with benzo(a)pyrene and lead. In addition, areas of soil outside the delineated area with significant amounts of visible lead pellets will also be excavated. This action will prevent further migration of the contaminated soils and will protect potential receptors from health threats posed by direct contact and inhalation of airborne particles.

This action will remove contaminated soils above the residential levels and will therefore not require any institutional controls for surface soils.
