Dear Mr. Davidson:

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has reviewed the subject document and finds it adequate for its intended purpose. EPA has one comment: In Section 1.0 Purpose, first paragraph, last sentence, the date should be February 5, 2001. EPA concurs with the selected action to remove approximately 43 cubic yards of contaminated soils. This action will prevent further migration of the contaminated soils and will protect potential receptors from health threats posed by direct contact and inhalation of airborne particles.

This action will remove contaminated soils above the residential levels and will therefore not require any institutional controls for surface soils.
