I have completed my review of the Action Memorandum for Operable Unit 5, Site 49 - Former Skeet Range, Naval Air Station Cecil Field, dated May 2002 (received May 13, 2002), prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. The Action Memorandum adequately describes the rationale for the excavation and disposal of soil contaminated with polynuclear aromatic hydrocarbons and lead. The attachments in the Appendices include the Removal Action Design Package, a Wetland Impact Memorandum, a Joint Application for Environmental Resource Permit, and the Recommended Wetland Restoration Specifications. Once the applicable regulatory agencies have reviewed and approved the work to be conducted in the wetlands, the Department concurs that the removal action should take place in order to remediate the site so as to be protective of human health and the environment.
