I have completed my review of the Technical Memorandum for No Further Action, Potential Source of Contamination 39, Flightline Outfalls, Naval Air Station Cecil Field, dated July 2002 (received August 5, 2002), prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. The report is suitable for its intent and is approved as final.

The Department concurs with the recommendation to reclassify stormwater outfalls 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 8A, 9, 9A, 10, 12, 13 and 14 from Grey to Light Green to denote that releases of hazardous substances have occurred, but at concentrations that do not require a removal or response action. The Department also concurs with the recommendation to reclassify stormwater outfall 11 from Grey to Dark Green to denote that releases of hazardous substances have occurred and remedial actions have been taken to protect human health and the environment. With the excavation of PCB contaminated sediment from stormwater outfall 11, no further remedial action is required at that location. The Jacksonville Airport Authority should be made aware that sediments in the immediate vicinity of the discharge points at several outfalls have indicated the presence of some contaminants that may need proper handling and disposal when future maintenance or upgrades of the stormwater conveyance system occur.
