I have completed my review of the Operations and Maintenance Report, Nutrient Injection System, Building 46, Former Tanks 46R, 46D, 46SUL, 46UL, January 1, 2002 – March 31, 2002, Naval Air Station Cecil Field, dated July 2002 (received July 23, 2002), prepared and submitted by CH2M Hill Constructors, Inc. The report adequately describes the operations of the remedial systems and groundwater contaminant concentrations trends at this site for the first quarter of 2002.
