Dear Mr. Davidson:

I have completed my review of the Building 233 – Site Characterization Sampling, Analysis and Soil Disposal Letter Report, dated January 7, 2003 (received via e-mail January 7, 2003), prepared and submitted by CH2M Hill Constructors, Inc. The report adequately describes the efforts to determine the level of contamination, if any, present in the soil associated with work conducted by the City of Jacksonville in installing an oil/water separator, as well as providing information on the disposal of the soil excavated. The report clearly indicates that the soil excavated by the City of Jacksonville contained petroleum contamination exceeding Florida soil cleanup target levels and that this soil was properly characterized and disposed off site. The report also implies that contaminated soil was left on site. As the area excavated is within the footprint of the Site 37 groundwater plume, groundwater is being addressed by remedial actions associated with that site. Please note that in the future, if it is ascertained that the remaining contaminated soil associated with Building 233 interferes with the planned remediation of groundwater at Site 37, that this contaminated soil will need to be addressed.
