I have completed my review of the Source Removal Report, Excavation of Benzo(a)pyrene, Pesticide and PCB Contaminated Soil at Site 25, Former Transformer Storage Yard (Buildings 101 and 247), Naval Air Station Cecil Field, dated September 2002 (received January 17, 2003), prepared and submitted by CH2M Hill Constructors, Inc. The report adequately documents that the excavation and disposal of 98 tons of hazardous waste contaminated soil and 5,136.16 tons of non-hazardous contaminated soil from the site were completed in accordance with the approved Dig and Haul plan. The report also documents that during soil excavation activities, approximately 500 gallons of hazardous waste liquid was generated, transported and disposed.
