I have completed my review of the Source Removal Report, Excavation of Arsenic, Contaminated Soil at Site 21, Golf Course Maintenance Area, Naval Air Station Cecil Field, dated February 2003 (received February 27, 2003), prepared and submitted by CH2M Hill Constructors, Inc. The report documents soil excavation activities that occurred in August 2002. While the report adequately documents the excavation and disposal of contaminated soil as specified in the April 15, 2002 Dig and Haul Package, the Department cannot concur that the removal has resulted in the site being remediated to unrestricted land use as is written in Section 3.0 of the report.
