I have completed my review of the Source Removal Report, Excavation of Lead and/or PAH Contaminated Soil from Operable Unit 5, Site 49, Former Skeet Range, Naval Air Station Cecil Field, dated May 2004 (received May 10, 2004), prepared and submitted by CH2M Hill Constructors, Inc. The document adequately describes the excavation, transportation and disposal of 6,945.57 tons of non-hazardous lead and/or PAH contaminated soil and 949.17 tons of hazardous waste lead contaminated soil from the site. The report also details site restoration activities including backfilling of excavated areas with clean fill and wetlands restoration. While I concur that source removal activities and site restoration activities were completed in accordance with an Action Memorandum dated May 10, 2002, I cannot concur at this time that site restoration activities have remediated the site so as to be protective for potential future residential use.

Also, while the Source Removal Report appears suitable for its intended use in documenting soil remediation activities, the report was submitted as a draft with signature pages unsigned. Please finalize this report by sending completed signature pages for the document.
