I have completed my review of the Technical Memorandum for No Further Action, Storm Sewer Excavation North of Taxiways Delta and Alpha, Naval Air Station Cecil Field, dated December 2004 (received December 14, 2004) prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. The report documents the investigation into potential environmental contaminants within the Storm Sewer Excavation that potentially could cause the rash that developed on several workers of a subcontractor for the Jacksonville Airport Authority after working within the excavation. The investigation included the sampling of soils and storm water within the excavation and their analysis for EPA Appendix IX analytes and chemical warfare analytes. The investigation did not detect concentrations of any contaminants that would likely cause the symptoms noted on the workers. The report is adequate for its intended use and can be finalized.
