
RE: Phase VI Well Abandonment Work Plan, Naval Air Station Cecil Field, Florida.

I have completed my review of the Phase VI Well Abandonment Work Plan, Naval Air Station Cecil Field, dated February 27, 2006 (received by e-mail February 27, 2006), prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. Except for a couple of editorial comments, the Work Plan is suitable for its intent and is approved. Please fix the following:

- (1) This is the Phase VI Well Abandonment Work Plan. The heading for Table 1 says it is the Phase IV Well Abandonment Work Plan and the figure of the Main Base denotes the locations of monitoring wells to be abandoned as the Phase V locations. Please fix it so that it correctly identifies this as the Phase VI work plan.
- (2) There is a monitoring well on the figure for Buildings 860/864LS, south of the Building 860 wells to be abandoned, that is not shown as being proposed for abandonment. Please verify that this well should not be on the list for abandonment.
