The Department of Environmental Protection concurs that based upon the information contained within the Sampling and Analysis Report for the Abandoned Railroad Bed North of Normandy Boulevard, Naval Air Station Cecil Field, dated November 2006 (received November 13, 2006), no further action is required for the Unrestricted Section and that no further action with Land Use Controls is acceptable for the Restricted Northern and Southern Sections.
