RE: Remedial Action Optimization Report for Building 46, Naval Air Station Cecil Field, Jacksonville, Florida.

Dear Mrs. Nwokike:

The Department has completed its review of the Remedial Action Optimization Report for Building 46, Naval Air Station Cecil Field, dated May 2007 (downloaded from CH2M Hill's ftp site on May 25, 2007). The recommendation of the report is to focus the current biosparge treatment only to those areas that exceed the Department's natural attenuation default concentration (NADC) criteria, quarterly monitoring of monitoring wells exceeding NADC criteria (CEF-46-1S and CEF-46-7I), and annual sitewide groundwater monitoring including wells in the downgradient portion of the intermediate zone plume. The proposed alternative is acceptable to the Department. However, as this site is currently being remediated under a Remedial Action Plan Approval Order, a document will be required showing the specifics of the modifications to the treatment system and groundwater monitoring plan that is signed and sealed by a Professional Engineer.
