I have reviewed the Draft Sampling and Analysis Plan, Tanks 81 A, B, and C, Naval Air Station Cecil Field, dated April 2010 (received April 13, 2010), prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. I have the following comments on the Draft Sampling and Analysis Plan:

- (1) Please add Limit of Detection (LOD) to the list of acronyms and abbreviations. (Page 27)
- (2) On page 25, Section 10.3.2, please replace "Floridian Aquifer" with "Surficial Aquifer".
- (3) On page 25, Section 10.3.3, please remove the parts where it says isopropylbenzene or contamination exceeding human health criteria remains. The concentrations of isopropylbenzene detected in groundwater exceed the Department's groundwater cleanup target level for isopropylbenzene which is based on organoleptic considerations, not human health concerns.
- (4) On page 27, Section 11.1, please change where it says that the response will be formulated to mitigate potential health risk associated with contamination. See comment (3).
- (5) In Section 11.2, Project Action Levels (PALs), please explain how the limit of quantitation (LOQ) values compare with Practical Quantitation Limits (PQLs).
- (6) On page 34, third bullet from top, it refers to ARARs. As this is a petroleum

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contaminated site, please refer to the applicable section of Chapter 62-770,
Florida Administrative Code.
