I have completed my review of the Draft Sampling and Analysis Report for Building 605, Naval Air Station Cecil Field, dated October 2002 (received October 30, 2002), prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. The draft report is suitable for its intent and may be finalized. As the concentration of chloroethane in groundwater has decreased to below its groundwater cleanup target level during two consecutive semi-annual groundwater monitoring events, I concur with the recommendation that no further action is required at this site. I am less clear on the appropriate color classification for the site. However, it is evident that whatever the color classification ultimately determined for the site, the color classification would reflect that the property is transferable.
