The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has received and reviewed the Final Technical Memorandum for Plume Delineation for OU 2, Site 5, NAS Cecil Field, Jacksonville, FL (FL5170022474) dated January 2013. This letter provides approval for the report as it is adequate for its intended purpose. EPA concurs with the recommendations to add three additional groundwater monitoring wells (CEF-005-31S, 32S and 33S). The EPA also continues to stress that the erosion of the adjacent soil pile apparently continues to affect the Navy's ability to monitor Site 5. It is the responsibility of the Navy to work with the City and have the situation corrected.
