I have reviewed the Phase XIII Sampling and Analysis Work Plan, Site 15, Blue Ordnance Disposal Area, Naval Air Station Cecil Field, dated January 20, 2005 (received by e-mail January 20, 2005), prepared and submitted by TetraTech NUS, Inc. The work plan specifies the collection of two soil and two groundwater samples to be used to determine whether dioxins in soil and perchlorate in groundwater are potential contaminants of concern. The work plan proposes collecting soil samples from 0 to 1 foot below ground surface. The proposed locations for the soil samples and the monitoring wells proposed for groundwater sampling are acceptable to the Department. The work plan is therefore approved.
