Dear Mr. Davidson:

The Department has completed its review of the Draft Feasibility Study Report for Site 15, Blue 10 Ordnance Disposal Area, Naval Air Station Cecil Field, dated May 2005 (received May 26, 2005), prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. I have the following comments on the report:

- (1) Page ES-3, last bullet on bottom of the page, please change the 2.04 mg/kg background arsenic concentration number to 2.1 mg/kg, the new residential soil cleanup target level for arsenic.
- (2) Page ES-5, second to last sentences of the second and third bulleted paragraphs, please change hypothetical future residential receptors to hypothetical future low-impact recreational receptors.
- (3) Page ES-5, last sentences of all three bulleted paragraphs, please change "prevent residential land use" to "prevent residential, commercial/industrial and high- and medium-impact recreational uses." Please make the same change on Page ES-7, second sentence of first bulleted paragraph, and to the first sentence of the last paragraph on that page.
- (4) In Tables 1-1 through 1-13, please update the cleanup target levels. Also, the references should be to FDEP soil cleanup target levels (SCTLs) established in Chapter 62-777, Florida Administrative Code (April 17, 2005). The current SCTLs and reference are to the old Chapter 62-777, F.A.C.
- (5) Please add Chapter 62-780, Florida Administrative Code, to the list of State Chemical-Specific ARARs in Table 2-2.


