I have completed my review of the Work Plan Addendum No. 21, Excavation of Contaminated Soil at Site 15, Blue 10 Ordnance Disposal Area, Revisions 00 and 01, Former Naval Air Station Cecil Field, Revision 00 dated November 2005 (received November 15, 2005), Revision 01 dated February 16, 2007 (received by e-mail February 21, 2007), prepared and submitted by CH2M Hill Constructors, Inc. Revision 01 to the Work Plan Addendum added waste characterization procedures necessary to conduct soil excavation activities while implementing Munitions and Explosives of Concern avoidance procedures. Except for one error I found in Revision 01 which I discuss below, Work Plan Addendum No. 21 and its revision are acceptable to the Department.

The error I found in Revision 01 to the Work Plan is that in Figure 6 and Table 3-3 R1, it has an excavation in Area F being conducted to 15 feet below ground surface. Pursuant to a decision made at the March 2007 Cecil Field BCT Meeting, the excavation in the area around the monitoring wells at Area F was only to extend to 2 feet below ground surface or the water table, whichever is smaller.
