I have completed my review of the Revised Draft Proposed Plan for Operable Unit 5, Site 15, Naval Air Station Cecil Field, dated April 2007 (received April 25, 2007), prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. I have the following comment on the Proposed Plan:

(1) The Land Use Controls described in the box at the bottom of page 1, within the discussion of the **Cleanup Alternatives for OU 5 Site 15** beginning on page 6, and within the section **A Closer Look at the BCT's Proposed Cleanup Plan** on page 8, leave out a very important component of the Land Use Controls. In Sections 3.2.2.1 and 4.2.4.1 of the Feasibility Study, Land Use Controls would "prohibit the excavation of soils from the site unless prior written approval is obtained from the Navy, U.S. EPA and FDEP." This part of the Land Use Controls is missing in the Proposed Plan.
