The Department has completed its review of the Draft Pilot Study Work Plan for In-Situ Bioremediation at Operable Unit 9, Site 59, Building 1845 Southern Area, Naval Air Station Cecil Field, dated June 2006 (received June 26, 2006), prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. The Department has the following comments:

- (1) Figure 3-1 has an incorrect scale. Please correct.
- (2) The extraction and injection well details on Figures 4-3 and 4-4 do not agree with the text in Section 4. The text has the wells screened from 42 to 52 feet bgs while the figures have the wells screened from approximately 65 to 75 feet bgs. I believe the figures to have been inadvertently copied without correction from the previous Pilot Study conducted at Site 59.

After making the corrections to the Work Plan, please submit a Final Pilot Study Work Plan that has been signed and sealed by a registered Florida Professional Engineer. If you have any concerns regarding this letter, please contact me at (850)245-8997.
