Dear Mr. Davidson:

I have completed my review of the Revised Draft Record of Decision for Operable Unit 9, Site 59, Naval Air Station Cecil Field, dated April 2007 (received April 3, 2007). I have the following editorial comments on the Revised Draft Record of Decision:

- (1) On page 2-2, second paragraph, last sentence, please change "Florida Department of Environmental Conservation" to "Florida Department of Pollution Control" or to "Florida Department of Environmental Regulation".
- (2) In Section 2.2.2, it begins by describing the 1998 Due Diligence Investigation (DDI) conducted in the areas of Buildings 815 and 1845. Later on page 2-4, in describing the Remediation Investigation studies, it relates soil and groundwater investigations in the Building 324 area to the DDI. Please fix the language so that it is clear that the investigations in the Building 324 area were related to a different Due Diligence Investigation that was conducted, I believe, in 2003.
- (3) On page 2-6, Section 2.4, second bullet, please change (Class G-I) to (Class G-11).
- (4) On page 2-20, last bullet on page, second sentence, please insert the word "Injection" between the words "Underground" and "Control".
- (5) On page 2-21, Section 2.11.4, second sentence, it says "For soil, this was accomplished by evaluating . . ." This makes no sense as soil does not require a remedy and is not addressed in the Record of Decision.

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- (6) In Table 2-2, page 2 of 2, in the column for Alternative 4B and the row for implementability, it says Alternative 4B would be slightly more complex than Alternative 4. I believe that should be Alternative 4A.
- (7) In Table 2-4, second row, Florida's Drinking Water Criteria is in Chapter 62-550, Florida Administrative Code.
