I have reviewed the above documents, dated, respectively, April 13, 2007; April 26, 2007; September 7, 2007; and March 12, 2008 (received April 23, 2007; April 30, 2007; September 10, 2007; and March 14, 2008, respectively), prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. The reports are suitable for their intent. Also, I concur with the recommendation in the 1st Semi-Annual, Year 3 Groundwater Monitoring Report, to continue sampling groundwater on a semi-annual frequency but to limit laboratory analyses to benzene only because toluene, ethyl benzene and total xylenes have not been detected in groundwater samples since 2000.
