

Dear Mr. Bergstrand:

This letter serves as a request to SCDHEC to issue a well permit for one additional temporary well point in Zone A at Naval Base Charleston. Per discussions conducted at the June Project Team meeting, one additional groundwater sample will be collected from one temporary well using direct push technology (DPT) downgradient of AOC 505 (Creosote Cross-Tie/Ballast Storage Area and Golf Course Maintenance Building). The proposed well point, designated as 042GP004, is shown on the attached drawing. Samples will be obtained from the top of the Ashley Formation, which is anticipated to be encountered at approximately 45 feet below ground surface.

This submittal fulfills the requirements for notification to SCDHEC as stated in the *South Carolina Well Standards and Regulations Document R.61-71*. The temporary well will be installed by a state-licensed well driller. The subcontractor is scheduled to initiate DPT activities on approximately June 23, 1997.


