Subj: Initial Assessment Study at Naval Base Charleston for the Naval
Assessment and Control of Installation Pollutants (NACIP)

1. The NACIP program, managed through the Naval Energy & Environmental Support Activity (NEESA), was designed to identify contamination of Navy lands resulting from past operations and to institute corrective measures as needed.

2. The first phase of NACIP, the initial assessment study (IAS), involves collecting and evaluating all evidence supporting the existence of a contamination problem at the installation. This phase will be conducted by a consultant firm, Environmental Science and Engineering, Inc. (ESE) at Naval Base Charleston, from 27 July to 7 August 1981.

3. Mr. Richard Gardner of NEESA and Mr. Bruce McMaster of ESE will visit Naval Base Charleston on 8 July 1981. They will present a command briefing on the purposes and objectives of the IAS at 0900 in Building 12 in the second floor conference room. Addressees are requested to send a representative to this meeting.


