In response to the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control's (DHEC) site visits, and to fulfill the requirements of condition II.A.2 of the RCRA Part B permit issued to the Navy by DHEC and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the Navy acknowledges a potential new site located at the Charleston Naval Complex. The site visits have revealed addition paint booths in Building 177, in Zone E.

After discussions with BCT and DHEC staff members, the Navy proposes to include this paint booths and connection as an existing Area of Concern (AOC) entitled Paint Booths. Expanding AOC 571 to include similar operation in the same building, we believe will simplify record keeping and investigation efforts.
