The Corrective Action Engineering and the Hydrogeology Sections of the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (Department) have completed the review of the above referenced document, which was received on August 12, 2002. This review was based upon applicable State and Federal Regulations, and the CNC Hazardous Waste Permit, effective May 22, 2002.

As stated in the request, Building 194 was inadvertently identified as both SWMU 80 and AOC 566 during the RFA. The Department understands that AOC 566 was granted a No Further Action determination by the EPA on July 25, 2002. Given that AOC 566 is the same as SWMU 80, the NFA granted by the EPA should also stand for SWMU 80. Therefore, the Department hereby grants a NFA for SWMU based upon the recommendation from the EPA. Please note that this determination is granted based upon currently available data. Additional investigation may be necessary in the future if information becomes available warranting such action.
