Summary data for this site indicates detectable concentrations of Benzene and Naphthalene in groundwater at this facility. The reported contamination represents a violation of the PCA and should be investigated. Therefore, the NFA decision issued by the Department for this site dated 22 October 1997 is hereby rescinded.

The Department requests that the Navy submit a work plan for additional assessment activities at BLDG 2508. The assessment plan should propose proper sampling of the site for petroleum hydrocarbon contamination as outlined in the *South Carolina Risk-Based Corrective Action for Petroleum Releases* guidance document dated May 2001.
