The Department has completed technical review of the referenced document. **Interpretation of the analytical data provided in the referenced report indicates that chemicals of concern remain above established Risk-Based Screening Levels and MCLs. The Department concurs with the conclusions as presented in the report and routine groundwater monitoring and reporting should continue as prescribed in the Corrective Action Plan dated August 2000.**
