The Department has completed technical review of the referenced document. As submitted, the Remediation Monitoring Report provides a synopsis of corrective action activities performed to remediate hydrocarbon contamination at the referenced facility.

Interpretation of the analytical data provided in the referenced report indicates that free product persists at this site. The Department concurs with the recommendations of your contractor, free product removal and groundwater sampling activities should continue. Please review the well identification numbers and the figures for the next report, although well U36GW006 is referenced in the text and tables it does not appear on any of the figures.
