The Department has completed technical review of the referenced document. Interpretation of the analytical data provided in the referenced report indicates that chemicals of concern are above established Risk-Based Screening Levels in soils. The Department does not concur with the conclusions as presented in the report that this site be issued a No Further Action.

The Department requests that the Navy submit a plan to conduct semi-annual groundwater monitoring of this site for a period of one year. The purpose of this plan is to ensure that the residual hydrocarbon constituents in soils at the site do not present a continuing threat to groundwater.
