As you are aware, all rehabilitation activities associated with a release from a regulated UST system, as defined in R.61-92 (Underground Storage Tank Control Regulations), must be performed by a SCDHEC certified site rehabilitation contractor as required by R.61-98 (Superb Site Rehabilitation and Fund Access Regulation). As of the date of this letter, the author has not received information from the Bureau of Underground Storage Tank Management indicating that the Environmental Detachment Charleston has submitted an application for certification. In this regard, the author will hold for review all pending or future assessment/corrective action plans at regulated UST systems pending reconciliation of the certification requirement or demonstration that these activities will be performed or overseen by an UST certified contractor. This delay is intended to avoid potential enforcement actions should the facility interpret approval of assessment/corrective action proposals as approval to proceed without appropriate certification.
