a. Six each, 55 gallon drums, at the Brehm Laboratory, Wright State University. Contact is Dr. Michael Taylor, Telephone 873-2202.


b. One each, 55 gallon drum, at Bldg 450, Area B, WPAFB. Contact is Mr. W. McClure, Extension 54796.

2. Subsequent to the above action, please notify Ms. B. Vanderleest at Extension 73422 or 74503 for inspection and marking/labeling instructions. 6480 - Nonlisted (laboratory wastes) (NMFC 50320) compounds, tree or weed killing and para. 10-7a(2), AFR 71-4, applies.

3. Immediately after completion of marking/labeling in accordance with instructions received as a result of para. 2 above, all drums are to be placed on wooden pallets and readied for air transportation to: N62604 Naval Construction Battalion Center, Gulfport MS, attention: Mr. J. B. Adcock, Autovon 363-2214, commercial A/C 601, 865-2214.

4. The seven drums should move on LOGAIR Flight 5W clearly marked for a flagstop at Keesler AFB MS (BIX) the next day. Advise the TCC Shift Supervisor (Extension 74946) 24 hours in advance of the date when flagstop is to be made effective.
