1. During reference (a) and (b), discussions were held relative to entry into the disposal area which was secured as part of the Agent Orange Contamination Survey. The safety precautions and procedures to be used for entry into this area for the purpose of inspecting CESE components for possible reutilization were explained. We were further advised that entry could only be authorized by the CBC Commanding Officer.
2. In view of the above, it is requested that entry into the disposal area be authorized for the purpose of inspecting CESE components so that a decision can be made on purchase of a new component at a cost of \$10K or reutilize component from the disposal yard. This request is for inspection only. If the component is satisfactory for our use, we will wait until decontamination by the Air Force is completed prior to claiming component.
3. Safety precautions and procedures as explained by CAPT Stoddard are fully understood and will be complied with if entry is authorized.
