Subj: FENCING FORMER HERBICIDE ORANGE AREA AND DECONTAMINATION OF EQUIPMENT  
IN DPDO STAGING AREA

Ref: (a) PHONCON LT COL Steve Valder, AFESC/DEV /J. H. Cluff CBC Gulfport  
(Code 470.2) of 23 August 85

1. During reference (a) the status of the fencing of the former Herbicide Orange storage area and the decontamination of the equipment located in the DPDO storage area were discussed.
2. Headquarters AFESC/DEV is presently negotiating with Oak Ridge National Laboratory to decontaminate the equipment. No firm plan of action has been developed and he could not give a deadline for clean up. I requested the equipment be cleaned up by 1 October 1985 as per CO's orders. Valder could not give me a firm date as negotiations were continuing with Oak Ridge.
3. HQ AFESC/DEV is still waiting on the lab results to determine the boundaries of contamination. Until all results are in they can not issue a fencing contract. I expressed the CO's desire to have the fencing contract complete by 1 October 85. He was unable to establish a firm date.
4. LT COL Valder said he would inform me as soon as dates were established for decontamination and fencing. MAJ Ron Vogal is currently negotiating with Oak Ridge National Laboratory for the equipment clean up.
