1. During reference (a), several personnel expressed concern over past exposure to Herbicide Orange. Enclosure (1) explains the procedure for active duty military to follow in order to be placed on the Herbicide Orange monitoring program registry. Enclosure (2) outlines the procedures for civilians who wish to be placed on a monitoring registry.

2. If there are any concerned military personnel in your department/activity, have them report to the Branch Medical Clinic as described in enclosure (1). If there are concerned civilians who wish to be placed on the Air Force registry, forward their name, grade, SSN, duty title and current address to CBC Code 470.2. The information will then be consolidated and forwarded to the Air Force Surgeon General's Office for their records.
