Enclosed for your information is a copy of the soil handling and excavation plan for the research, development, and demonstration program at the Naval Construction Battalion Center, Gulfport, MS. Also enclosed is a copy of the sampling and analysis protocol plan. This latter document lists the constituents which will be analyzed and the appropriate methodologies to be used in addition to the methodologies for sample collection. The analyses will be performed following the verifications tests in November. These documents are transmitted to you in accordance with the RD&D Permit. Additional information will be provided to you in a separate transmittal.

The QA/QC plan for the sample analysis will be provided with the test data after completion of the verification test burn in November.

Procedures for the November 17 test burn are near completion and will be transmitted to you by November 3.

A detailed plan for collecting reliability and maintainability data for the routine 90 day testing will be developed following the verification tests in November and prior to routine testing which is expected to begin in late January. I would like to emphasize that the verification tests include a 72 hour clean soil test. Contaminated soil will not be processed prior to successful completion of that clean soil test. A checklist of the items to be inspected during the verification test is available upon request.
