UTILITY FEEDER DISPOSITION AT THE CODE ORANGE OPERATION SITE - CEF-52-88

Dear LCDR Fitzpatrick:


This letter is to document the intention of the Site Demonstration Project regarding the disposition of utility supply lines to the Code Orange site. The Navy's concurrence and or redirection regarding the stated intention is hereby requested by November 1, 1988.

- Natural Gas
The above ground gas line at the incinerator shall be removed to where the line enters the ground. The elbow will be removed that starts the vertical run below ground and the open pipe will be capped. The underground line to the connection at the main at 7th street will be abandoned in place. The abandoned line will be disconnected at the main and a permanent termination made on the main side of the disconnect. The abandoned line will also be capped at the main end.
- Water
This line was installed with the gas line and will be handled in the same fashion as the gas line.
- POTW
The above ground discharge line will be removed to its connection to the sewer system manhole. The connection interface will be restored to the original configuration.
- Electrical
The main power will be terminated on the pole at the Code Orange Site by removal of the wires on the bottom lugs of the breaker after the fused disconnects are opened. The wire from the pole to the loads will be removed and excessed.

The project will supply the Navy as-built drawings showing the abandoned lines and the details of the line terminations on the abandoned lines and at the mains.
