
TRANSMITTAL OF INTERIM DRAFT DECISION DOCUMENT - DJH-13-89

Dear Mr. Smith:

On October 19, 1988, representatives from the Air Force, the Navy, and EG&G Idaho met with you and Mr. Samuel Mabry to discuss the documentation needed for final termination of the Full Scale Demonstration Project at the Naval Construction Battalion Center in Gulfport, Mississippi. Since that time, we have drafted a decision document that describes the history of the project and demonstrates the cleanliness of the remediated former Herbicide Orange storage site. Three copies of that document are attached for your review.

Per your request, the document includes a simplified risk analysis for the remediated site. That analysis uses very conservative assumptions and shows that the risk of additional incidences of cancer are minimal. Please pay careful attention to that section (Section 6) to determine if it will meet your regulatory needs.

Following your review, we would like to meet with you, Mr. Samuel Mabry, and Mr. Calib Dana to discuss this document and any of its potential deficiencies in addition to future activities needed for final site disposition. As discussed in our telephone conversation yesterday, we would like to meet with you on May 25, 1989. Please confirm the acceptability of that date with Mr. Mabry and Mr. Calib. I will telephone you next week to confirm the meeting date and times. Mr. Jeff Short (Air Force LEEVO) and Mr. Tom Sarros (NCBC) will also be in attendance.


