Dear Mr. Stewart,

By copy of your letters dated 8 March and 16 March 1990, we have received your draft Administrative Orders for NAS Meridian and NCBC Gulfport, MS respectively. Due to the current Installation Restoration (IR) funding priority for these activities, we are unable to comply with your request for a Site Investigation schedule.

Environmental Sites in the IR Program are prioritized and funded based on specific criteria which include NPL status, Permit restrictions, and the Defense Priority Modeling (DPM) risk assessment. NAS Meridian and NCBC Gulfport are IR priority level 2 bases and will not receive IR funding until all priority level 1 activities are funded.

We will keep you informed of any changes in funding status and will provide a schedule at that time. We look forward to continuing a good working relationship with the state.

Also, as discussed during the 4 April 90 telephone conversation with you and our Mr. Reece Batten, the enclosed IAS is forwarded. The June 1989 Final SI Work Plan was provided to you by the ECOTECH letter dated May 31 1989.
